Opportunity for Investment

peanuts production has been showing positive trend for 2001-2005, even in 2005, there is a negative growth of production if it is compared with production in 2004. Meanwhile, domestic consumption tends to fluctuate. However, world consumption trends tend to increase. Average growth of domestic consumption is as much as 6.2% or equal 280 thousand tons in 2001 to 298 thousand tons in 2005.

Domestic consumption component is grouped to household and non-household.

From the household side, consumption level is fluctuating and tends to decrease, but non-household consumption tends to increase.

Production-Centre

East Java, Mid-Java and West Java are the biggest peanut producers in 2001-2005. Their share is 59.3% of total national production.
